We **believe** 2023 is the right time to have these conversations.

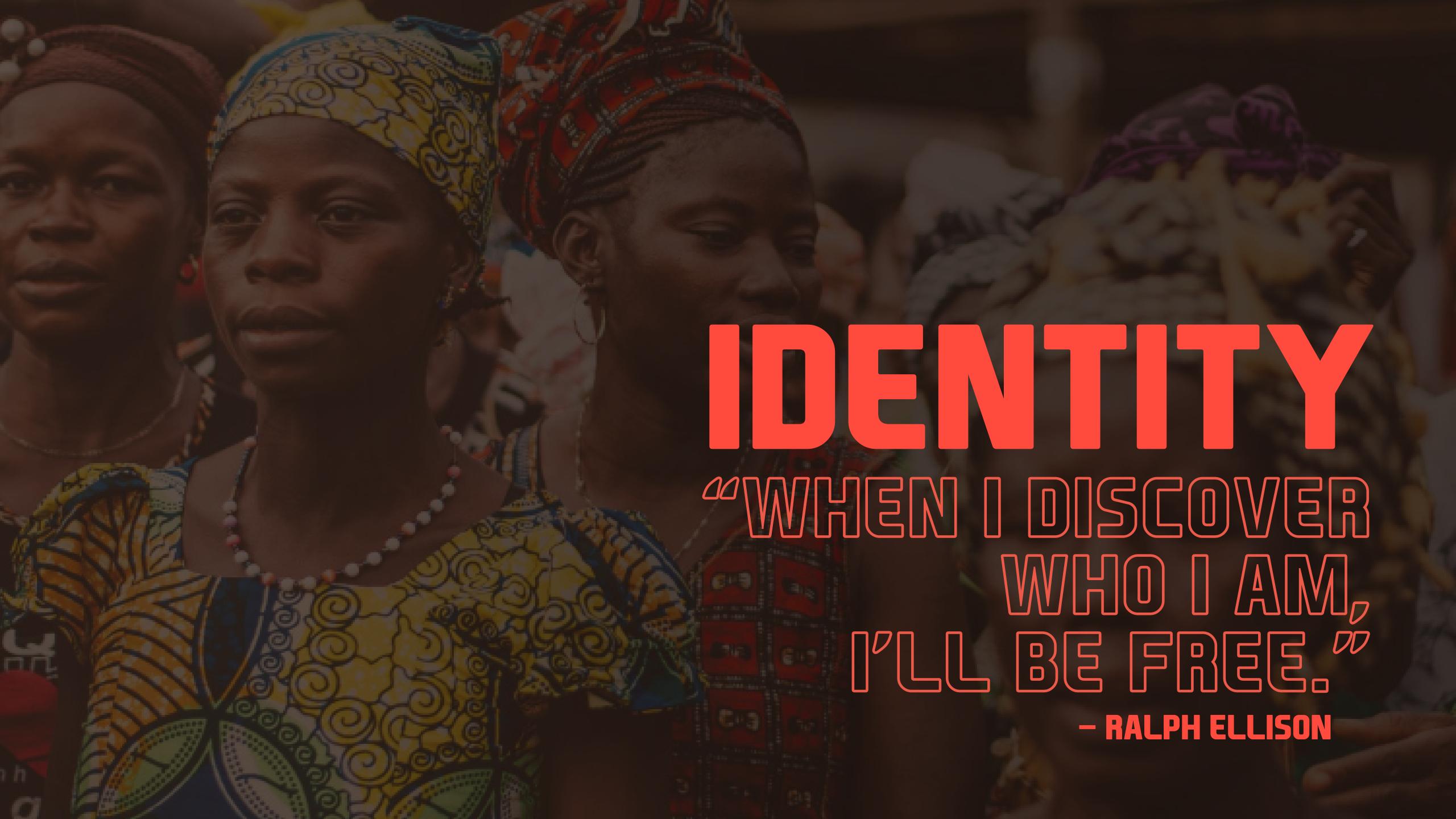
Imagine growing up in a world not knowing your roots, your family's history, or where you originally come from.

That's the case for millions of African Americans, Afro Caribbeans, and millions of Black people from the diaspora around the world. For all of its cruelty and horrors, perhaps the most damning sin of the Transatlantic Slave Trade was the stripping of the slaves' identity.

This has been a persistent issue throughout America's existence, particularly post-slavery when Black Americans began to develop their own identity.

America is a country of immigrants so most people are able to identify where their people are originally from before migrating to the states, except for African Americans. Through this documentary we will endeavor to reconnect our cast with their roots so that they too can learn about their true identities.

DISCOVERY

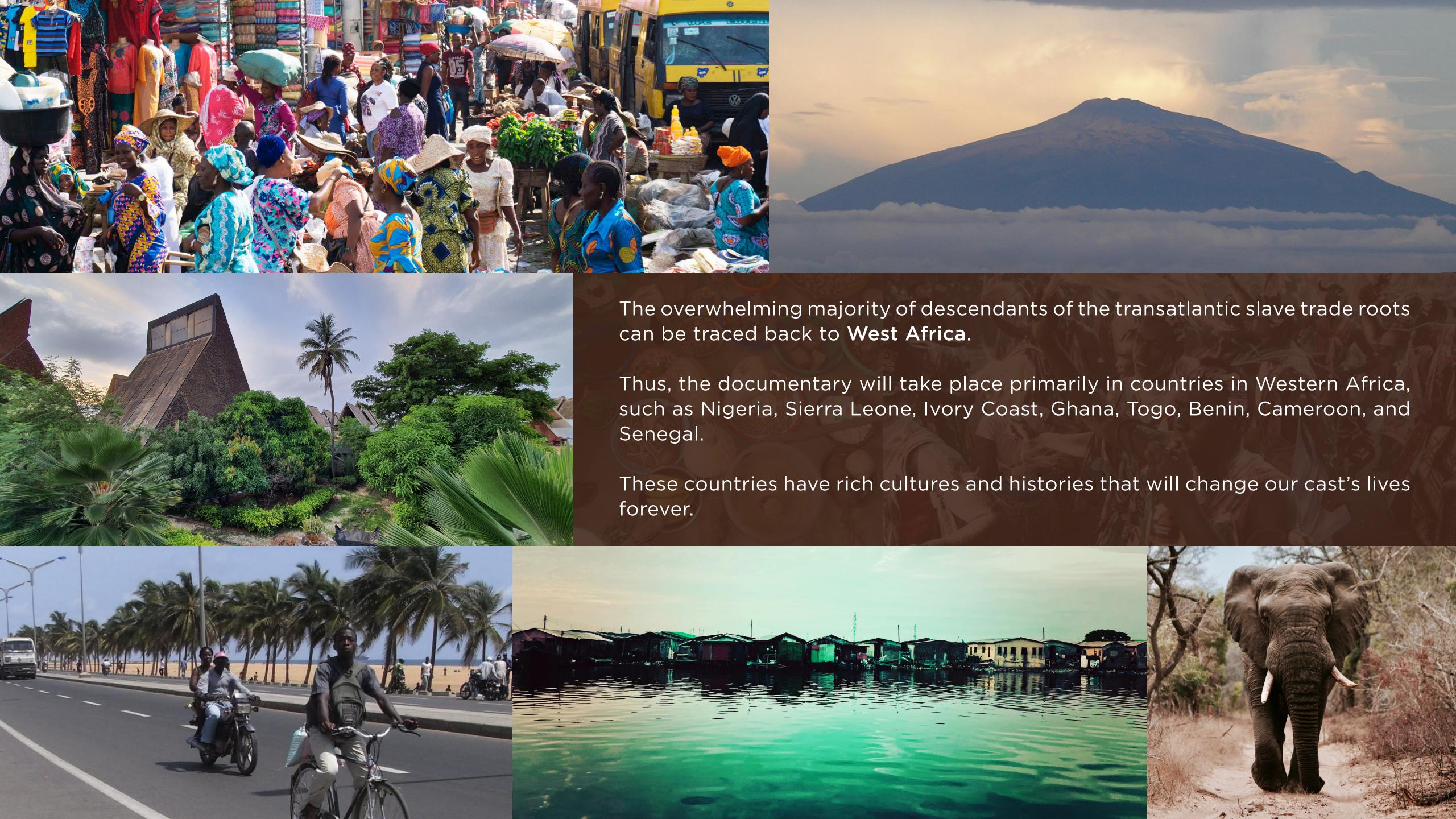
The cast of Homecoming will be given genetic DNA testing (African Ancestry or similar) to determine their roots.

A Telly award-winning partnership, Ian and Tim met in a documentary pitching class as graduate students at USC's School of Cinematic Arts.

After collaborating on small projects during that semester, they forged a creative alliance that they cemented when they flew to New York a year later to film Tim's thesis film, *Cal & V.* After graduation, Tim went into writing and directing, while Ian went into producing. In the years that followed, they continued to work together, creating well over one million dollars in productions that garnered tens of millions of views, ultimately leading them to bring their skill sets together under one roof with their company **Coco Butter.**



Timothy Offor earned B.A.s in Media Studies and English from the Pennsylvania State University. He later earned his MFA in Film & Television Production from the University of Southern California's School of Cinematic Arts.

Since graduating he has produced and directed nearly two million dollars in commercial branded projects for several partners including Neutrogena, Marvel, Synchrony Bank, Deutsche Bank, Frieze Magazine, REI, Meta, Walmart, Visa, CeraVe and Walgreens amongst several others.

He currently resides in Los Angeles, California where he runs Coco Butter a full service content studio with his business partner.



PRODUCER

Ian McClellan started as a company electrician on the 2012 Sundance Grand Jury Prize-winning film *Beasts of the Southern Wild*. He went on to associate produce for Academy Award-winning filmmakers Rob Epstein and Jeffrey Friedman on their documentary *The Battle of AmfAR* (premiered Sundance 2013). He earned his MFA at USC in film and television production in December 2016. The last thesis he produced, *Lalo's House*, won a Student Academy Award in 2018.

McClellan has produced from Los Angeles to New York and Rome to Bangkok on every kind of content from 6-second socials campaigns to feature-length films. His focus has been on turning the moments where directors say, "I know we can't film this part of the script because it's too crazy..." into actionable plans.

His feature film *Derek Changes His Mind* is currently in the festival circuit.
